Mr. Offley Malcolm Crowe-Read, of Plas Dinam, Montgomeryshire, formerly High Sheriff of that county, died on Wednesday, at Southock, in his 83d year. The deceased was the eldest surviving son of the late Mr. John Offley Crowe, of Llandinam hall, and of Wern, Flintshire, who assumed the name of Read, by Royal licence, in 1836; and his mother was Charlotte Prestwood, daughter of the late Sir Willoughby Lake, K.C.B. Mr. Crowe-Read was a magistrate and deputy-lieutenant for Montgomeryshire, and also a magistrate for Flintshire, and he served as High Sheriff of the former county in 1870. He was also a captain R.N., retired. He married, in 1848, Charlotte Lucy, daughter of Mr. Thomas M. George.
