ROBERT FITZROY alias CONSUL.
Created Earl of Gloucester, c. 1121.

Died 31 October 1147; buried at
St. James's, Bristol.
(Monumental inscription there.)

MABEL, eldest daughter & coheir
of Robert FITZHAMON, Lord of
Corbeil in Normandy.

Married in June 1119 at Lisieux.

of Leofric, Earl of Mercia (died 1057) by his

Foundress of the Priory of the
Holy Trinity at Repinton, co: Derby.
